**Subject:** Issuance of a Global Alternate Method of Compliance (AMOC) for Airworthiness Directive (AD) 2011-07-13 to Harrison Aero LLC on the basis of Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) SA01647WI approved by the Wichita Aircraft Certification Office

(3) Elevator Spar Outboard Hinge Bracket Installation Drawing List DL-HA1050, Revision IR, Dated August 23, 2011 or later FAA approved revision.  
(4) Instructions for Continued Airworthiness Document No. ICA-HA1050, Rev IR, Dated August 8, 2011 or later FAA approved revision.

Dear Mr. Harrison:

The Wichita Aircraft Certification Office has reviewed your request (Ref. 1) for a global AMOC to AD 2011-07-13 on the basis of the STC SA01647WI (Ref. 2) issued by this office. This letter grants your global AMOC request to AD 2011-07-13 on CPAC, Inc. Commander Models 112, 112B, 112TC, 112TCA, 114, 114A, 114B, 114TC airplanes.

This global AMOC is applicable to all aircraft listed in AD 2011-07-13 Section 2(c) and is transferable to any other owner-operator. This global AMOC applies to Section 2(g) of AD 2011-07-13.

The STC in Ref. 2 is issued for the installation of the elevator spar outboard hinge bracket assembly on the CPAC, Inc. Commander Model 112 and 114 series airplanes in accordance with Harrison Aero, LLC, Drawing List DL-HA1050 (Ref. 3). The Instructions for Continued Airworthiness (ICA) are in the document ICA-HA1050 (Ref. 4).

Incorporating the Harrison Aero STC SA01647WI (Ref. 2) and following the conditions listed below will show compliance to Section 2(g) of AD 2011-07-13.

Use of this AMOC to AD 2011-07-13 is subjected to the following conditions:

1. The installation instructions given in the document DL-HA1050 (Ref. 2) must be followed.
2. All periodic inspections that are specified in the ICA Document No. ICA-HA1050 (Ref. 4) must be accomplished as required by this ICA.
3. This AMOC addresses only the requirements of AD 2011-07-13. All other applicable ADs to CPAC, Inc. Commander airplanes must be complied with.

Before using this AMOC, notify your appropriate principal inspector, or lacking a principal inspector, the manager of the local flight standards district office/certificate holding district office.

All provisions of AD 2011-07-13 that are not specifically referenced above remain fully applicable and must be complied with accordingly.
